Keighley man dies in fall from hotel balcony

A Keighley family has spoken of its loss after a 24-year-old man was found dead while on holiday in Mexico.

Adam Pemberton had been in the middle of a luxury romantic getaway to Cancun with his fiancée Rosanne Broughan when tragedy struck.

His parents Keith and Heather flew out to Mexico after receiving the devastating news, but all the authorities could definitely tell them was that Adam had suffered a fatal fall from the balcony of his hotel at Riu Caribe.

Mr Pemberton, of Bracken Road, Keighley, said although Adam had moved to Leeds, the whole town was mourning the loss of his big-hearted, fun-loving and extraordinary son.

He said: "He will never be forgotten, the town will still be talking about him in 20 years to come – he was that much of a character and touched that many lives.

"In his 24 years he did more than what 80 per cent of other people will ever do. He lived life to the full and when he walked into a room he radiated that to everybody and lit them up."
