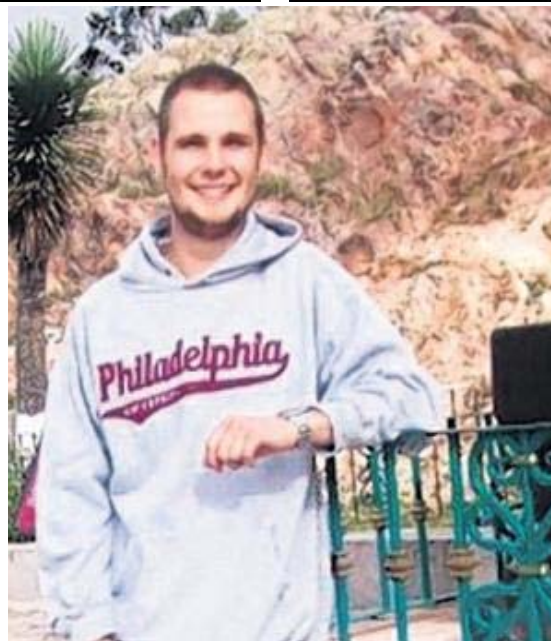
### Southampton student Phil Pain is improving after blacony fall in Mexico

A SOUTHAMPTON student who fell from a hotel balcony in Mexico is improving in hospital after having rare blood supplies flown to his doctors.
